## Program Details

The program is 6 weeks long from June 3 to July 15. This allows you to complete 2 lecture classes plus a language, culture and travel course. 9 CREDITS! The language and culture class meets your area 2 requirement.

This program is offered through the European Study Abroad Center (ESAC) and the University of Economics (VSE) in Prague. No tuition or student fees are paid to Virginia Tech. The program is a non-VT program due to the lack of tuition. Your program fee does include fees to VSE for its services.

## Student Housing

Students will stay at 3Domy apartments in fully-furnished units near the city center and university. The apartments have kitchen, balcony, Wi-Fi and more. The building quiet hours are 10pm-7am. This will be strictly enforced. There will be night security staff at the apartments.

These courses are core courses or electives towards the requirements of Pamplin majors & the International Business Minor.

The classes are offered through the University of Economics (VSE) in Prague. The classes will transfer to VT and you will have a transcript from VSE. You will have a GPA for the semester and should include that on your resume.

## Eligibility

Any student meeting the prerequisites for the courses. Any Pamplin major is welcome.

Minimum GPA: 2.3

## Passports

You need a passport valid for at least 6 months after you return, January 2018..

Apply for your passport right away. You can apply at the Blacksburg Library on Miller St or at the Post Office on University City Blvd.

## Registration

Acceptance is based on your GPA. There are 40 seats available for the program. The program fills quickly.. Prague is one of the most popular cities in Europe.
